HPC Workplan Review

- Submitted by our HPC:
- The purpose of the West Central Historic Preservation Committee is to foster improvement of the West Central neighborhood through preservation of historic structures and places using an established revitalization process; promotion of compatible residential and commercial growth and development; procurement and rehabilitation of historic or architecturally relevant [add: vulnerable] neighborhood structures; education and promotion of local, state, and federal historic preservation resources; and public education about West Central history to build both connectedness and stewardship.
- Comments: This statement will be presented at the membership meeting next week.

2024 Budget

- Review & approve: All previously discussed changes were made. Additional changes to H&G Tour budget to increase Trolley budget and Signage Budget.
- Anita introduced motion to approve the budget, seconded by Joel. Approved unanimously.
- Update on accountant engagement: George and Joel met with the accountant. They will do our books on Quickbooks (so we have a backup copy). They will rebuild the books starting from 2019.

2024 Priorities Approval

- Ranked survey results: 1) Existing WCNA programs, 2) Neighborhood Crime deterrents, 3)
 Bike boulevards & safe trails, 4) Historic Preservation, 5) Moody Park Improvements, 6)
 Signage, 7) Trade Scholarships
- Discussion: We need to narrow down priorities to about 3, so that we are not over-extended and priorities are meaningful.
- Programs/Theft deterrence. Discussion: we could add porch boxes/package vault to the list of qualified purchases for the security program (50% up to \$50). Organize an event to meet neighbors and exchange phone numbers to promote safety in the neighborhood. "Safety Saturday"

- Bike / Pedestrian improvements: Chris Leonard is trying to get a grant for the neighborhood to improve walkability.
- Empty houses and problem rentals: Alan suggested getting landlords together to brainstorm solutions to the most common issues. Ben Wahli discussed ways to identify all landlords in the neighborhood. Kelly suggested "hooking" them with reminder that they can also apply for the neighborhood programs. Next steps: Ben and Alan will meet separately to plan further.
