

WHAT DOES IT LOOK LIKE TO BE A TOUR STOP?

JUNE



- The front of your house is photographed
- The tour stops are announced on our social media and photos added to our website
- Tickets go on sale to the public

JULY



- You are assigned a House Captain - an experienced volunteer who will guide you through the process
- We hire someone to do research on the unique history and architecture of your home
- You have first dibs to fill any volunteer docent slots at your house before the sign-up list is sent out to past volunteers

AUGUST



- Your House Captain will do a walkthrough with you and offer suggestions on the flow of traffic and any rooms/areas to close off (you do not need to allow people to see or enter every room of your house!)
- Your House Captain will coordinate and communicate with all the volunteer docents assigned to your home

SEPTEMBER



- The day before the tour, your House Captain will assist in laying carpet masking if needed and rope off rooms/areas (having visitors wear shoe covers is also an option)
- Pre-Tour Party (time and location TBA)
- Tour weekend (Sat & Sun, 11am-5pm) - Your home will be open to visitors & you receive free tickets to enjoy the tour
